Antiques	Per discretion of LHFH staff
Appliances	100% working order, clean, less than 10 years old – Dishwasher 2014 or newer
Architectural items	Mantels, columns, and stained glass. Free of structural damage. No water damage or mold
Bricks and Blocks	Not broken, dirt free, neatly stacked, DROP OFF ONLY
Cabinets	Gently used with doors and drawers, wood and metal. Medicine cabinets new to gently used, no broken glass
Copper	Any length, any age. For recycling purposes ONLY
Countertops	New to gently used (granite, Corian, Formica)
Doors	All types, no broken glass or rotten wood
Drywall	½" thick sheets no smaller than 16"x16" 5/8" thick sheets no smaller than 24"x24"
Electronics/Flat screen TV's	In working condition
Flooring/Carpet, tile, and hardwood flooring	New to gently used. Tile should be unbroken, clean and boxed when possible
Flooring/Vinyl/Linoleum	6'x6' sheets or larger or peel and stick tiles in the box
Flooring-Laminate	Boxed or bundled only
Furniture	Dining room sets: new to gently used Bedroom sets: new to gently used Mattresses and Box springs: no stains or tears; must be a set China Cabinets, Hutches, and Entertainment Centers: new to gently used Sofa's, Couches, Loveseats, Chaises: no stains or tears; NO HIDE-A-BEDS
HVAC equipment and furnaces	Less than 10 years old and in working condition
Hardware	Knobs, hinges, locks, and pulls (no rust, in working condition)
Home Décor	Artwork, vases and knick-knacks. New to gently used, not broken
Insulation	New in complete packages only
Lawn and Garden	Fencing, shovels, rakes, birdbaths, lawn furniture and umbrellas new to gently used, cleaned and ready to sell. Grills only in good condition.
Lawn mowers	In working condition
Lighting	Light fixtures and ceiling fans with all pieces included
Lumber	6' or longer. Plywood ½ sheets or larger. Trim free of rot, nails, and screws. NO SCRAP
Mirrors	Framed, decorative mirrors only. None larger than 3'x5' accepted
Misc.	Discontinued and/or overstock business items
Office equipment and supplies	Desks, office chairs, filing cabinets, bookcases and office supplies
Paint/Paint Supplies	½ of can or more, less than ONE (1) year old – NO OIL BASED
Plumbing	New faucets, pipes, and pipe fittings due to new lead regulation laws (Kitchen and bathroom faucets new only; MUST include lead content) 2014 or newer
Roofing/Shingles	Partial to full bundles
Safety Supplies	New: gloves, safety glasses, hard hats and first aid kits
Siding	Boxed when possible, product should not have damage
Toilets	Must contain bowl, tank, and tank lid
Tools	Power and hand tools in working condition
Tubs, showers, and shower/tub units	New to gently used. Shower doors tempered glass ONLY!

Water Heaters	Year 2014 or newer - in working condition

***All donated material must be in 100% working condition, free of mold, rust, water and/or structural damage and free of lead paint.**

Unacceptable Donations: ANY ITEM THAT NEEDS MAJOR REPAIR, ANY GAS APPLIANCE, glass, used/stained mattresses, electronics with obvious defects, appliances with obvious defects, kitchen and bathroom faucets that do not comply with new federal lead laws, florescent light fixtures, no opened or partially used items, no organs, used garage door systems/openers, hazardous chemicals, pesticides, medical supplies, food products, animals, VCR's and VHS tapes, box style TV's, guns, ammunition or other weapons, alcohol, used tires, infant and toddler items such as: cribs, strollers, and car seats, or any additional item(s) that may be deemed unsafe and/or unsellable per the discretion of LHFH staff/personnel.
